

# Women in the Workplace



IN THE UNITED STATES



**1.8M** fewer women

are in the U.S. labor force now compared to before COVID

Women held **38%** of manager-level positions

at the beginning of 2020, while men held **62%**

Women comprise **47%**

of the U.S. workforce, but



**51%**

of the U.S. population

**1 in 4** corporate women

say they are considering downshifting their careers or leaving the workforce altogether



**57.5%** of women

aged 20+ were participating in the workforce in June—the lowest in 30+ years

Women leaving the workforce is costing the U.S. economy

**\$650B** annually



**44%** of women said they were the only one in their household providing care when schools and day care shut down, compared to just **14% of men**



Women's jobs were found to be almost **2x** as vulnerable

as men's jobs during the pandemic
